Dig into this letter, filled Spirit-given reflections on the power of God to rescue fallen humanity from sin, and the resulting life in the Spirit that empowers us to live a life of service & obedience before the Lord...

Dig deeper into the teachings of Romans, to grow deeper in the grace & knowledge of Jesus Christ...

How does sin's weaponizing of the law (7:13), end up revealing the spiritual goodness of God's law? Dig into Romans 7:14-16, James 1:21-22 and 1 Corinthians 3:1-4

## Living Out Our Faith

Ponder your response to these questions, to keep growing in the obedience that comes from faith...

As you read Paul's candid confession in 7:14-25, how does that help you to be real & transparent with others in the church family?

Read through Romans 7:15-20 again, and then set Galatians 5:16-18 alongside it. What fresh insights does this give you, on the nature of the war within? If your life were a football game, how's it going? What quarter are you in? Are you on the defensive or the offense? Where do you need help? What difference does it make when Jesus is on the field with you?

How does sin make us a POW of sin (7:23), and how does Christ free us from that law, to live life by the Spirit. See Romans 8:1-2; Galatians 2:19-20; 1 Peter 2:11-12. When have you experienced Jesus rescuing you from a sinful pattern that you could not overcome? How did that play out? How might Jesus be wanting to rescue you now?
